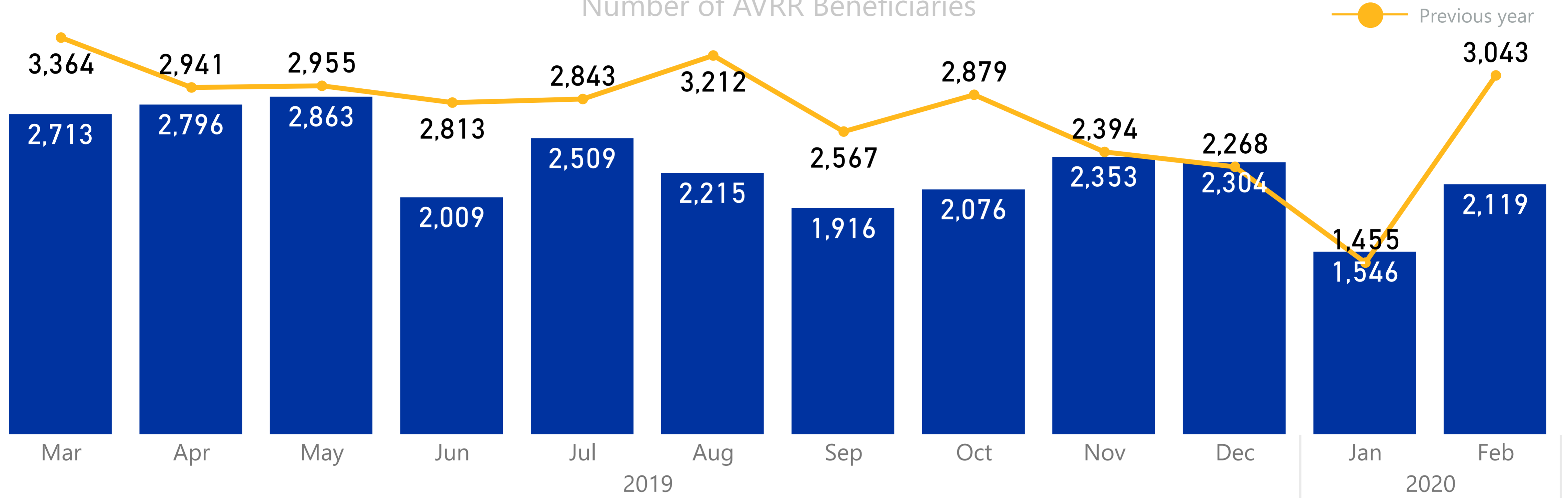


Since January 2020, IOM has assisted **3,665** migrants to return, compared to **4,498** migrants in the same period in 2019

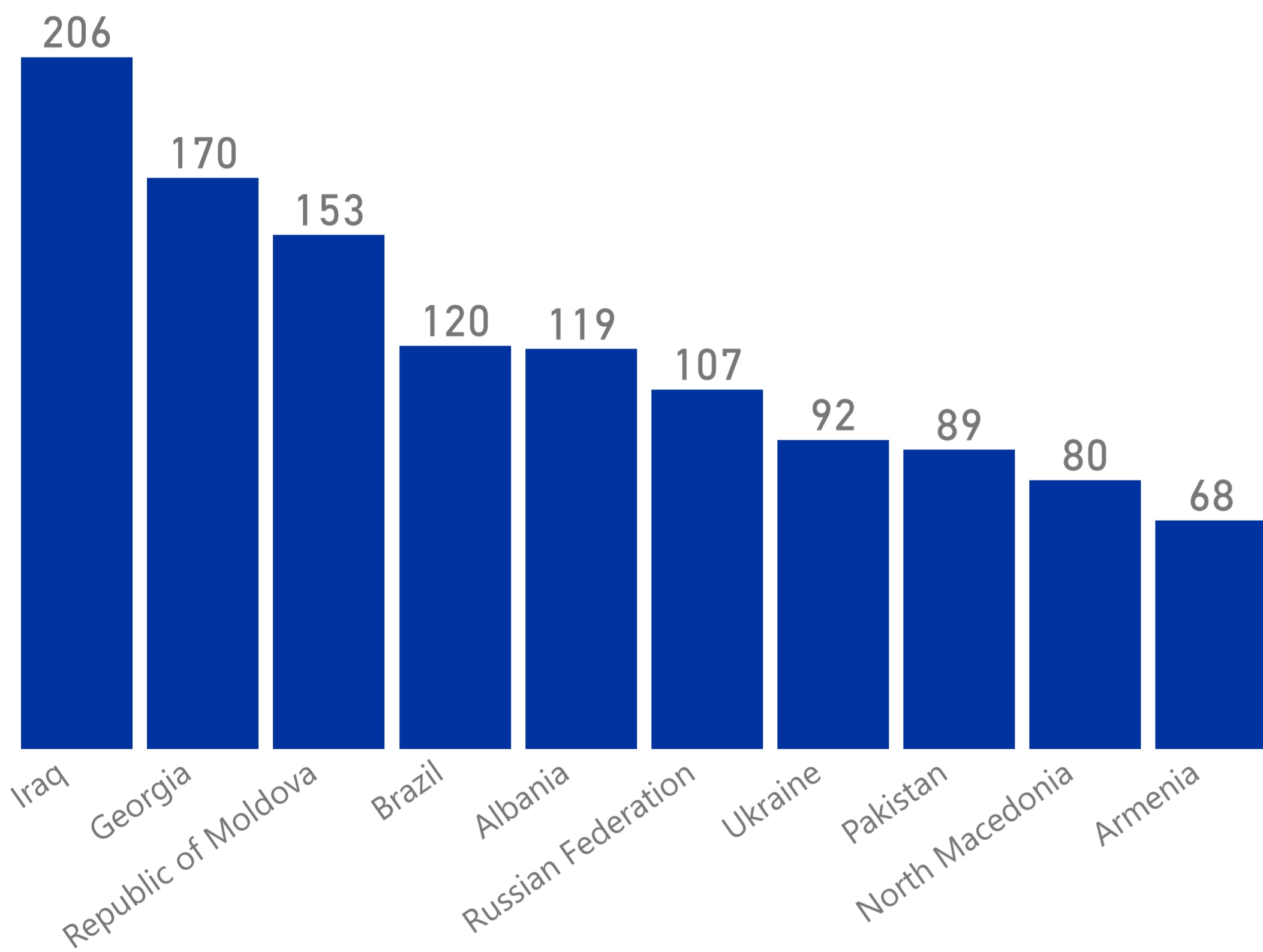
This month, IOM has assisted **2,119** migrants to return from the EEA+ region to **94** countries

Also this month, IOM has assisted **6** victims of trafficking, **6** unaccompanied migrant children and **75** migrants with health needs

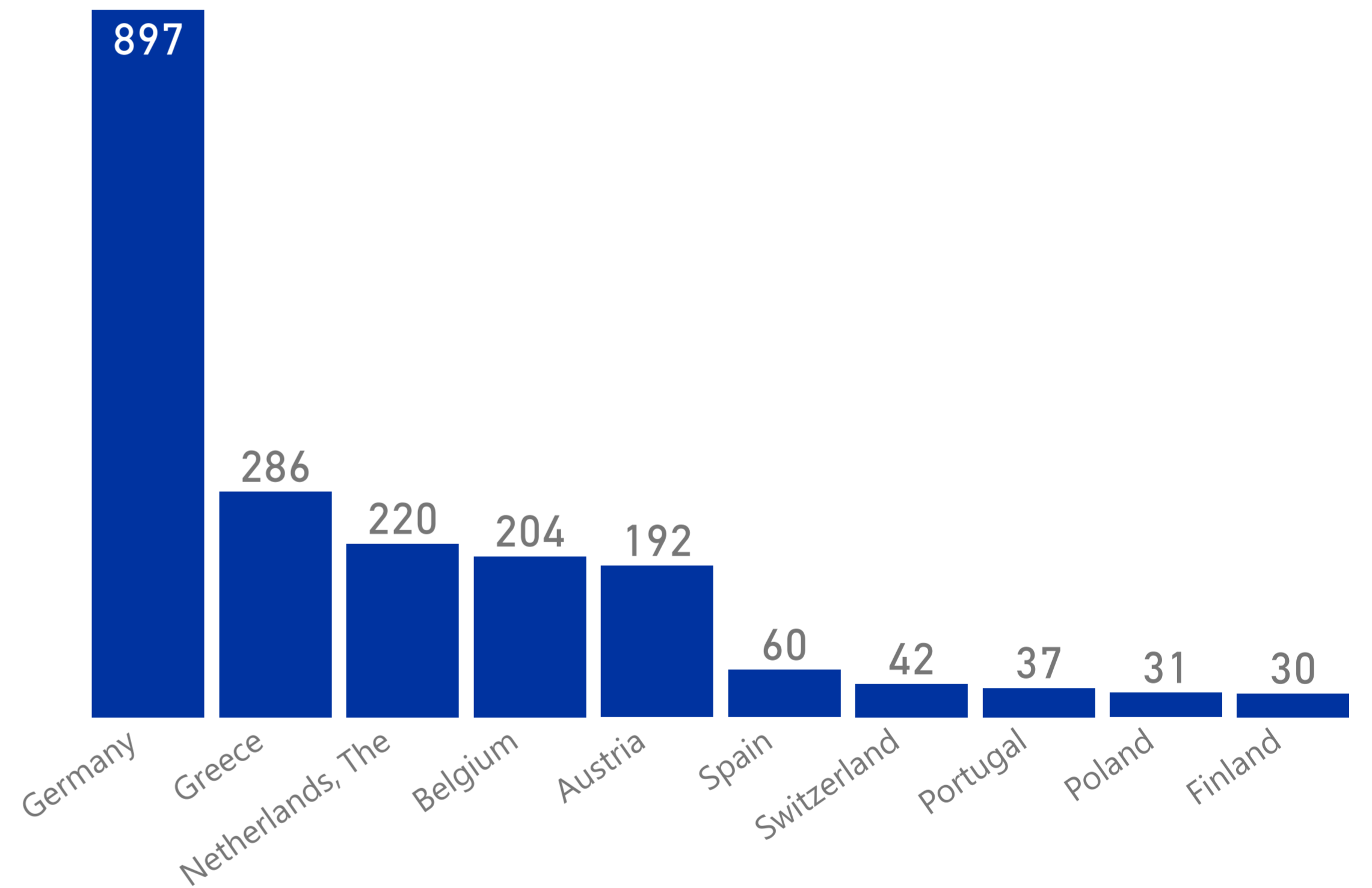
Number of AVRR Beneficiaries



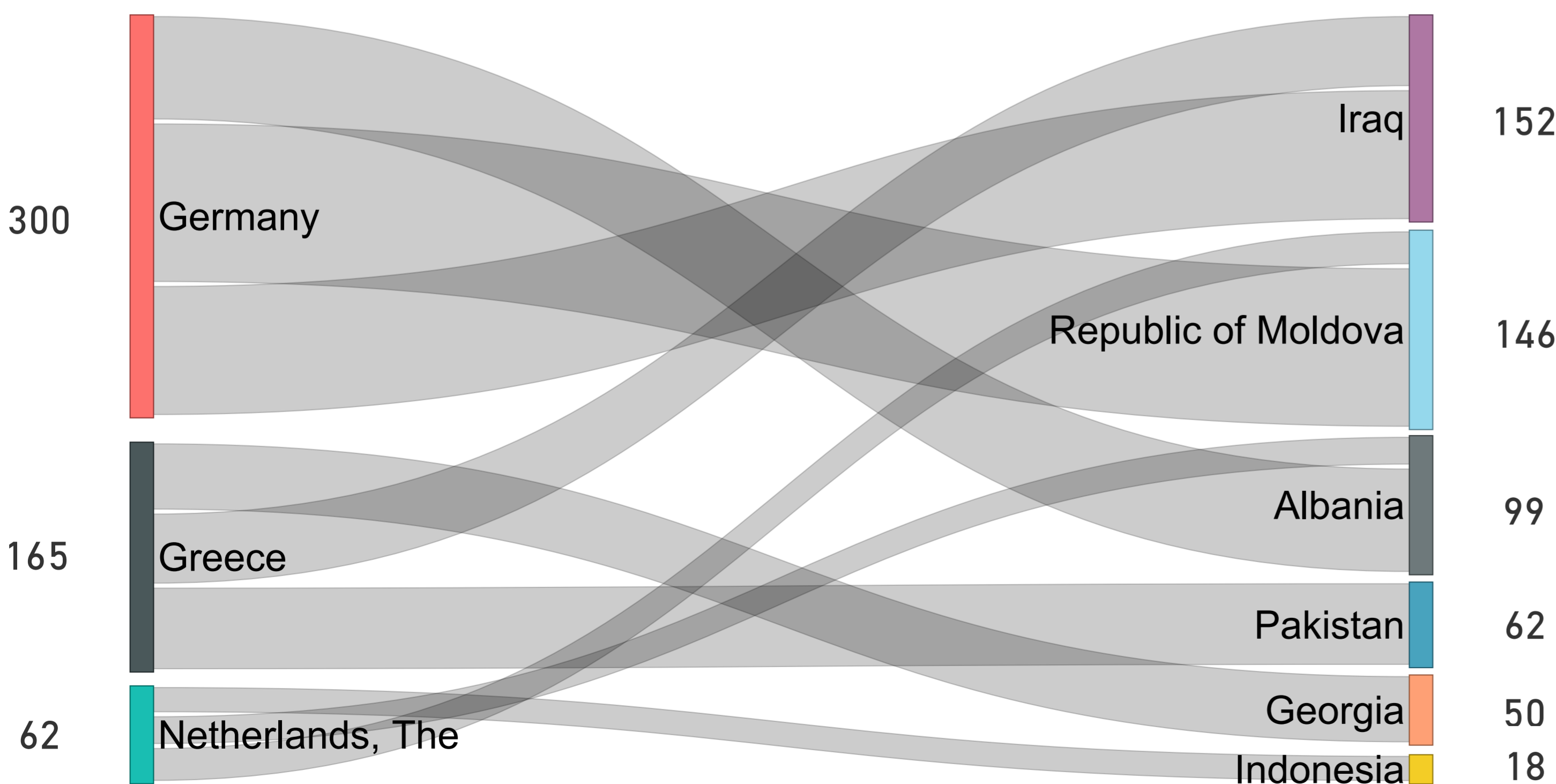
Top 10 countries/territories of origin - February 2020



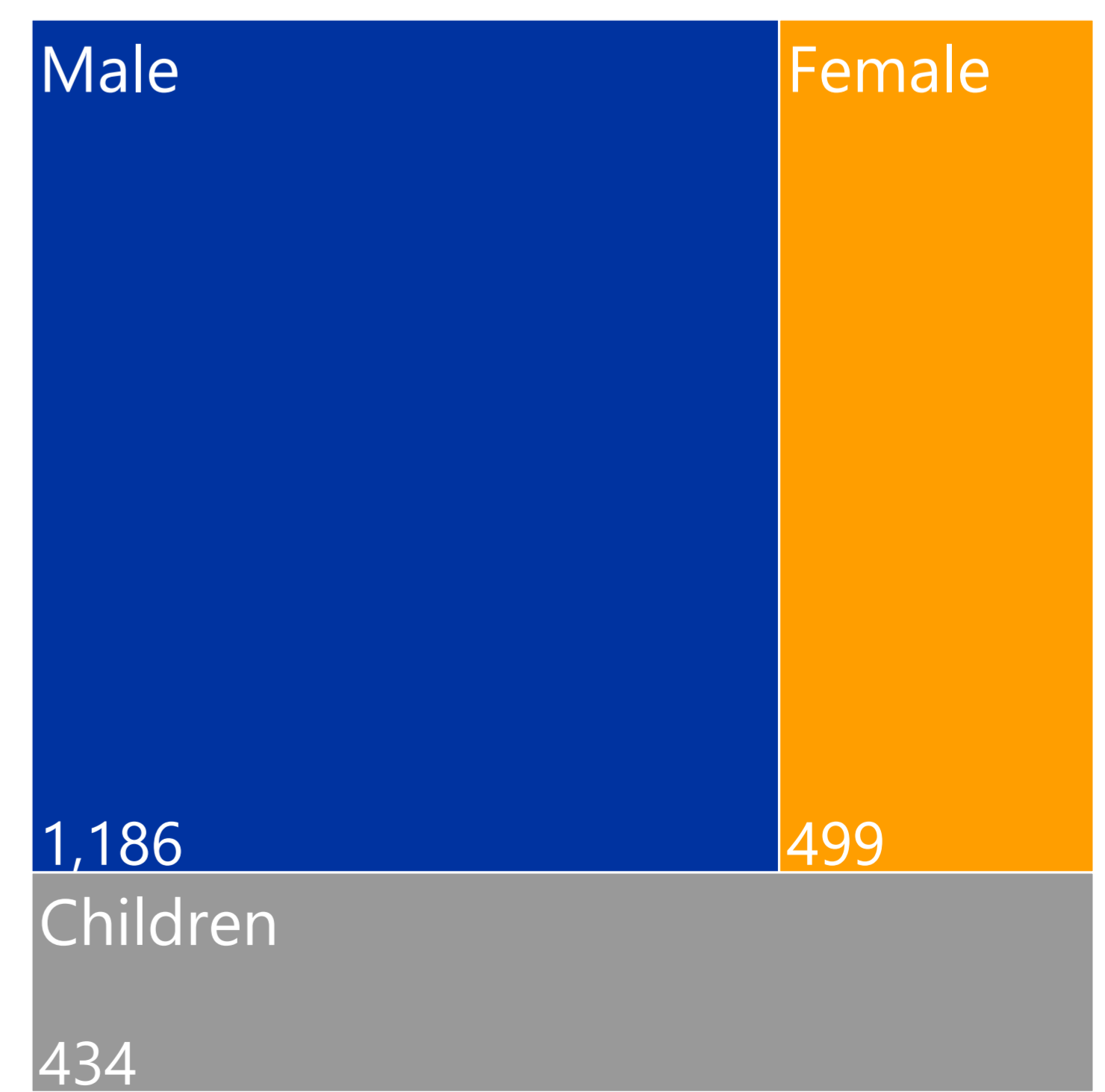
Top 10 host countries - February 2020

February 2020

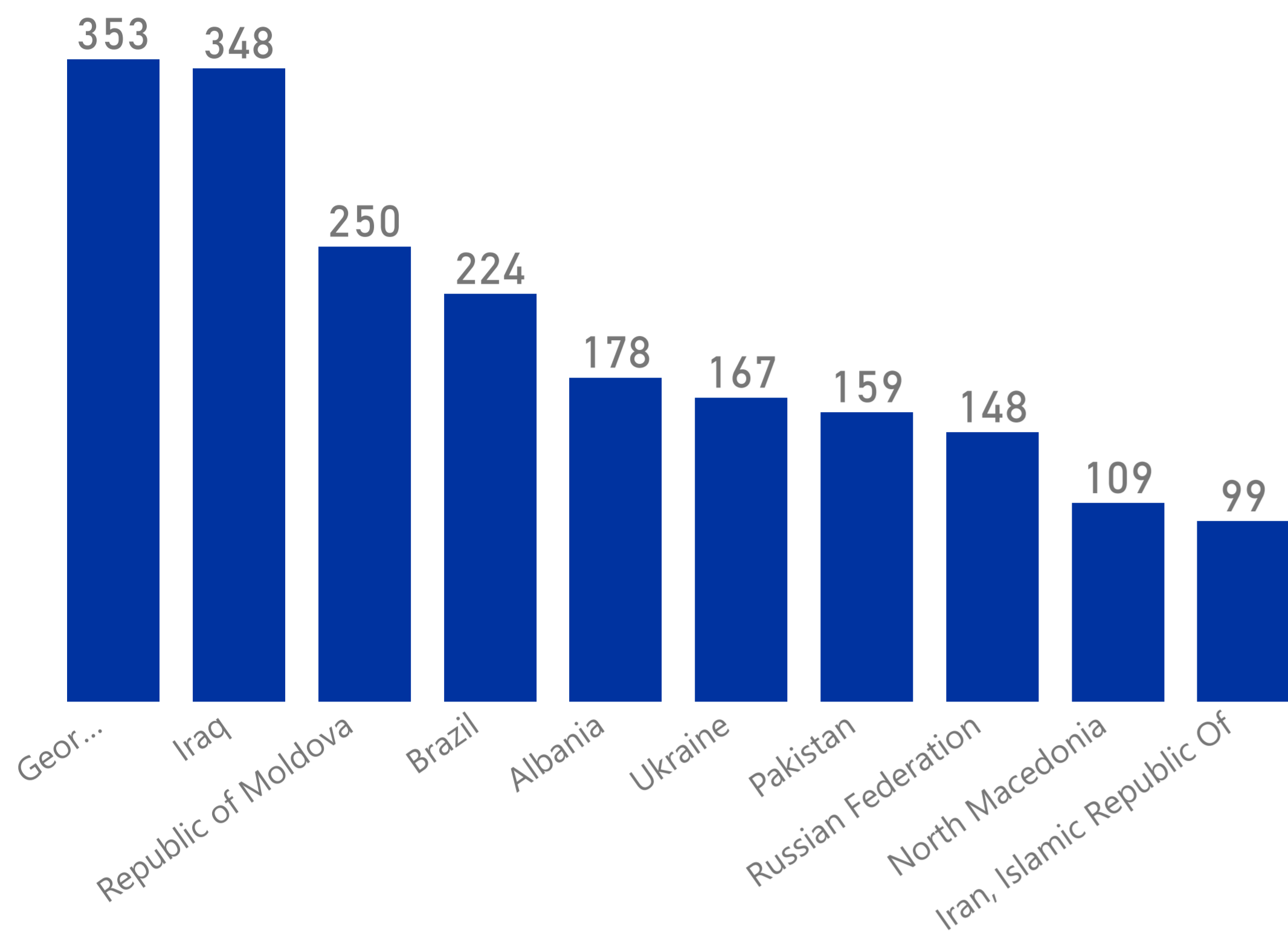


Age and sex breakdown
February 2020

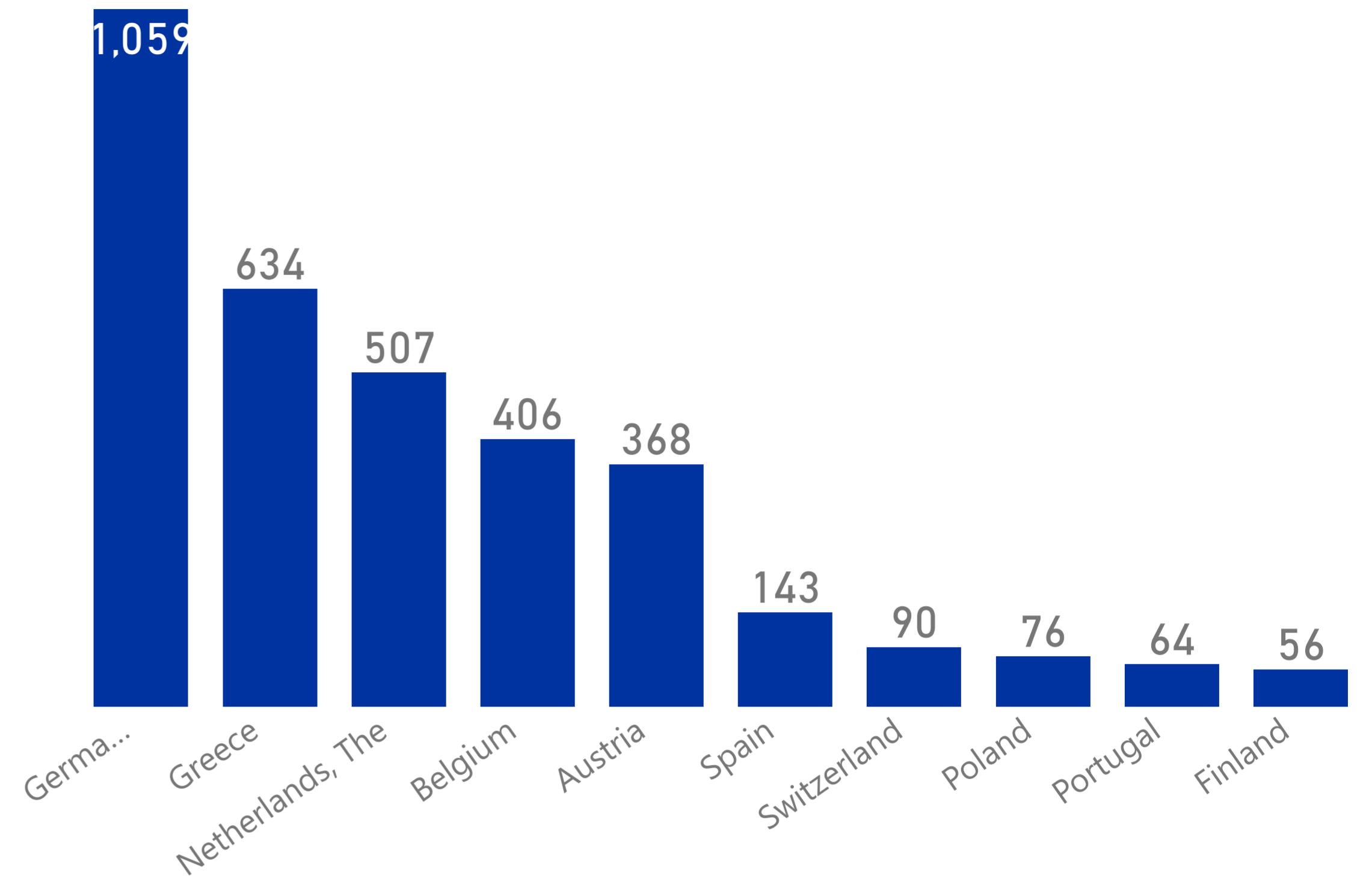

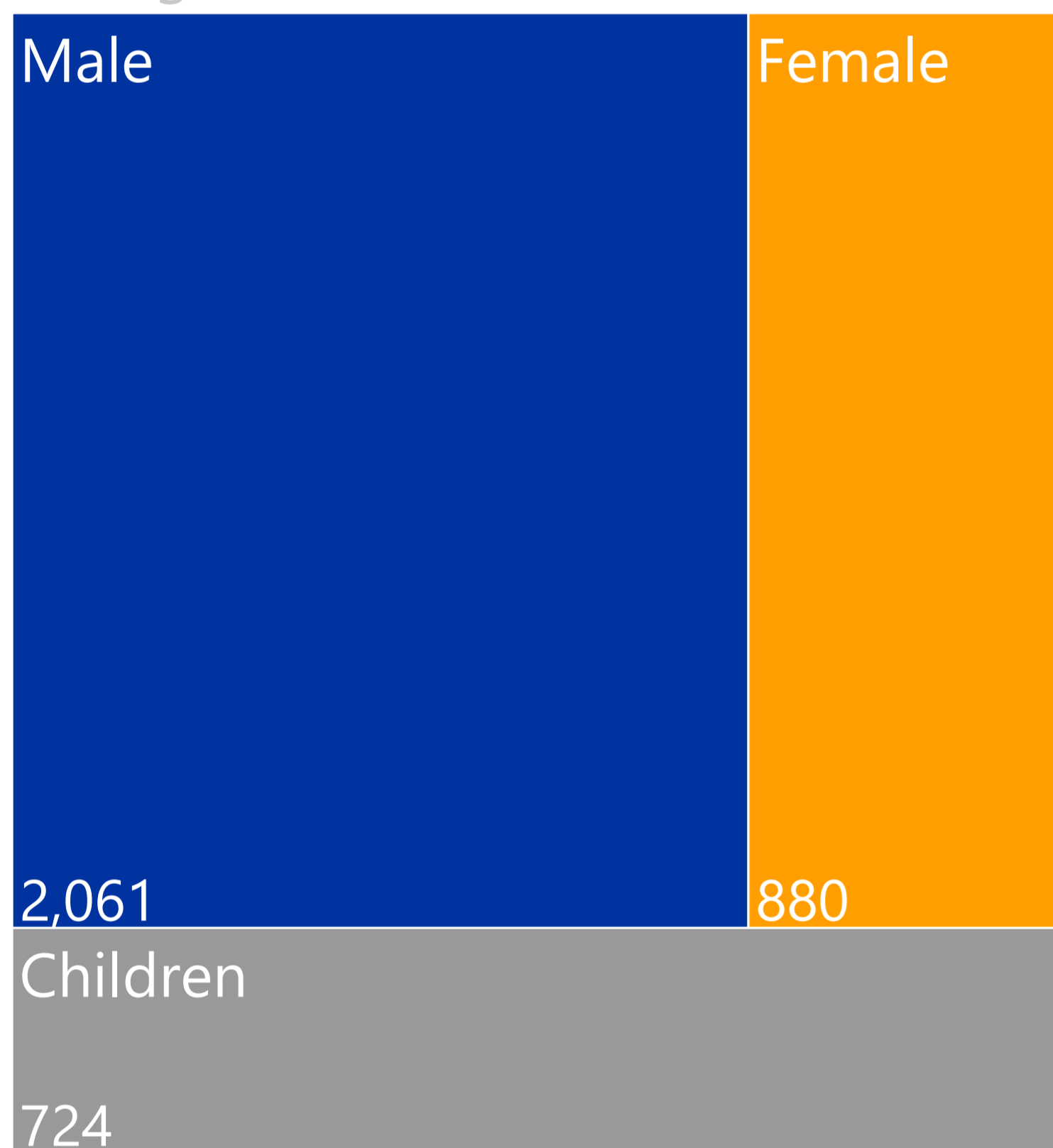
Top 10 countries/territories of origin - 2020

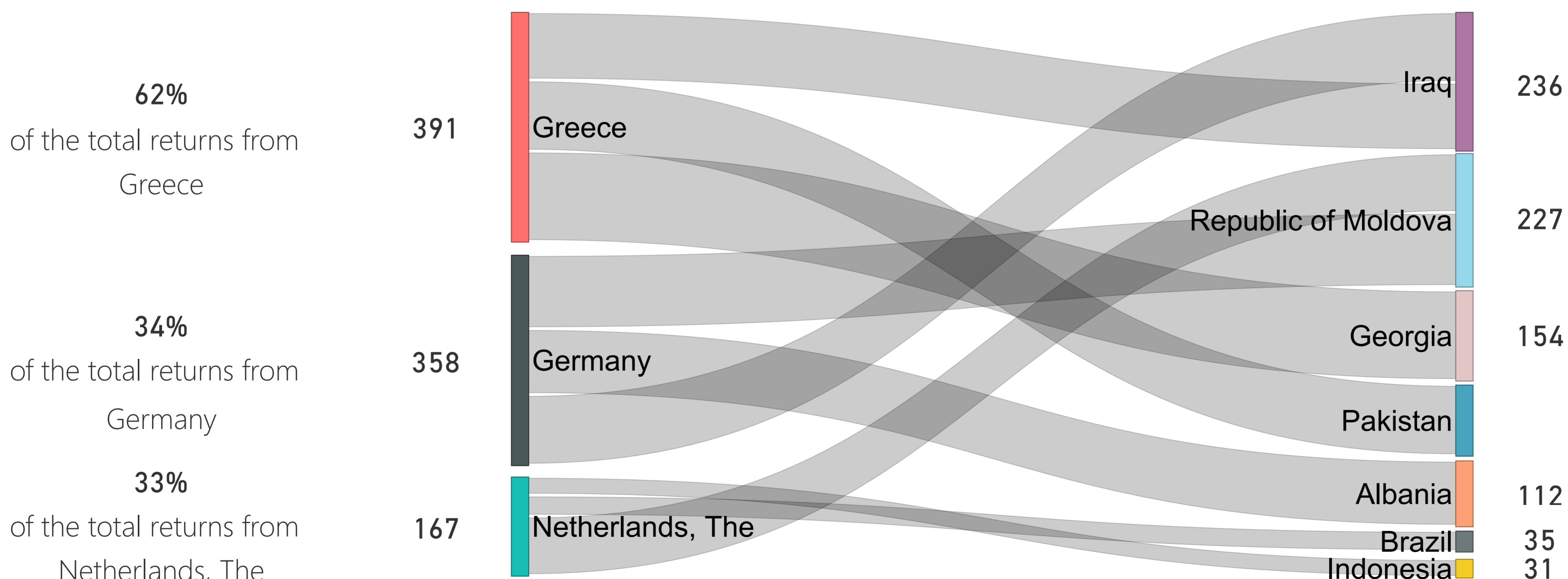


Definitions
