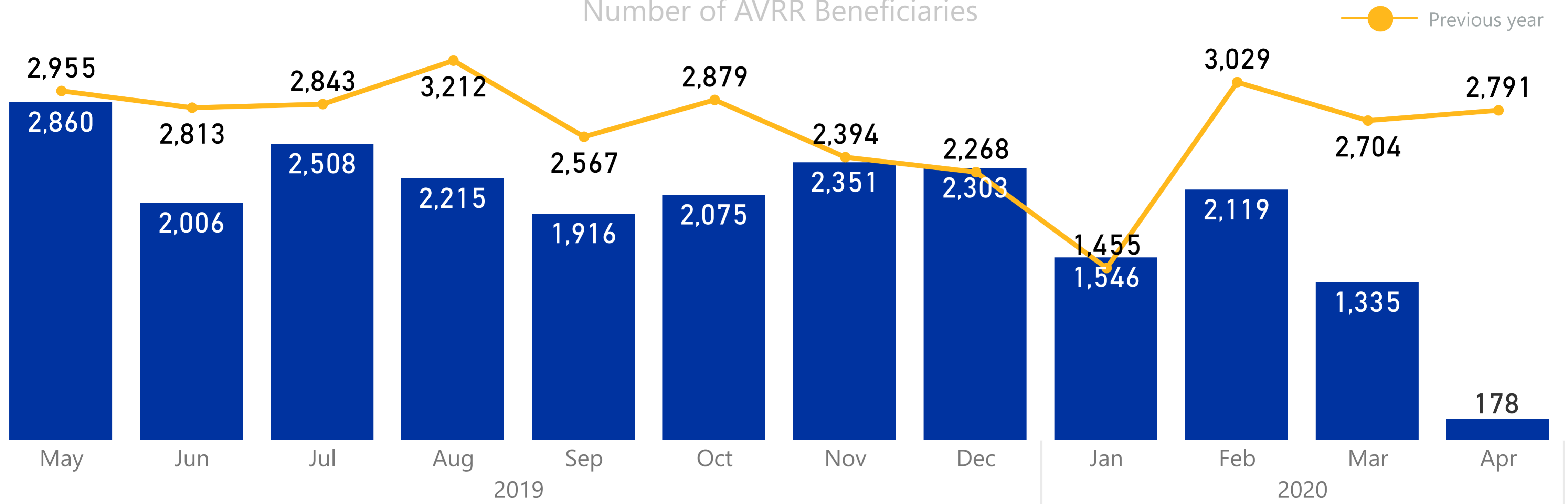


Since January 2020, IOM has assisted **5,178** migrants to return, compared to **9,979** migrants in the same period in 2019

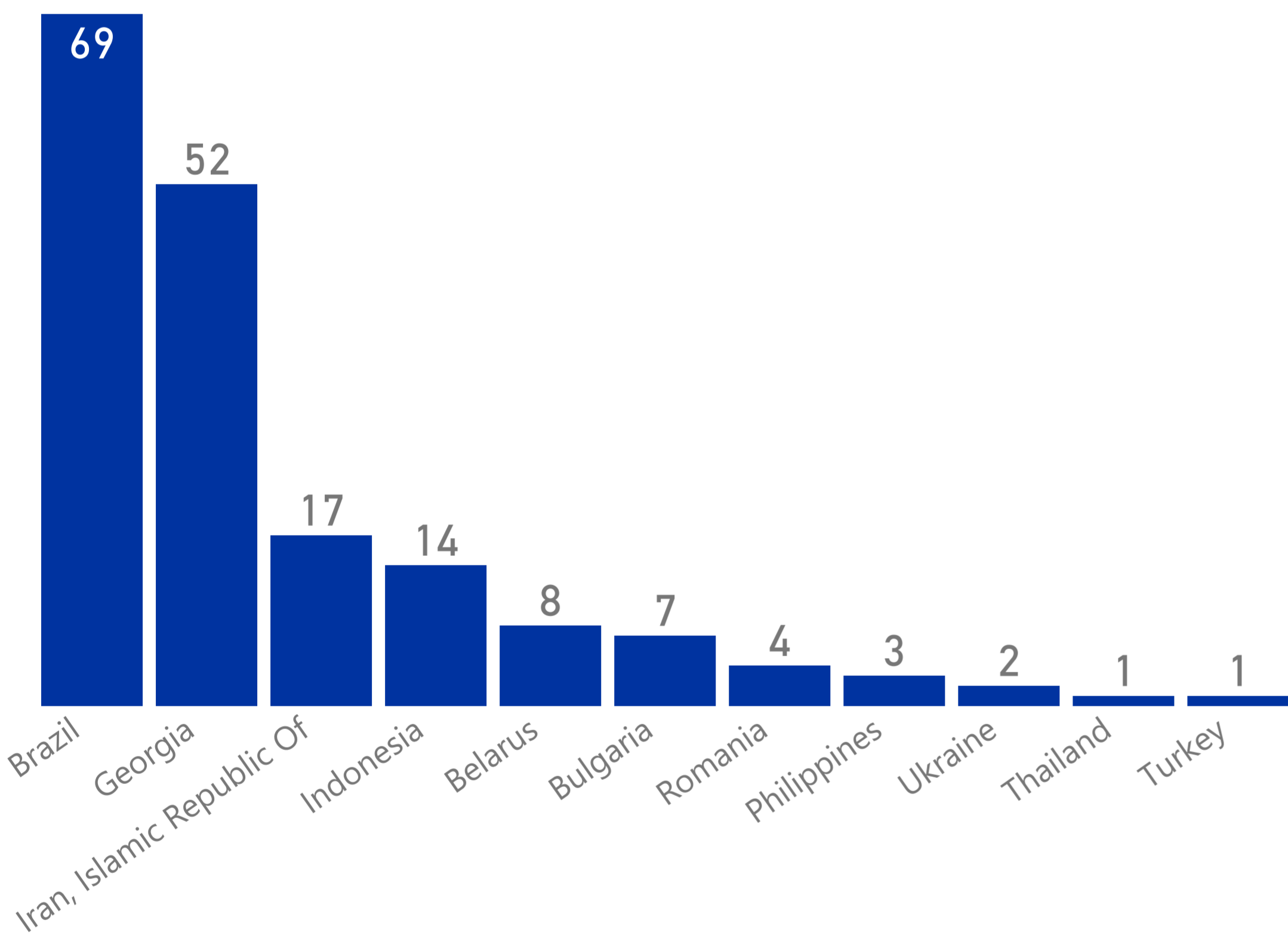
This month, IOM has assisted **178** migrants to return from the EEA+ region to **11** countries

Also this month, IOM has assisted **1** victims of trafficking, **0** unaccompanied migrant children and **8** migrants with health needs

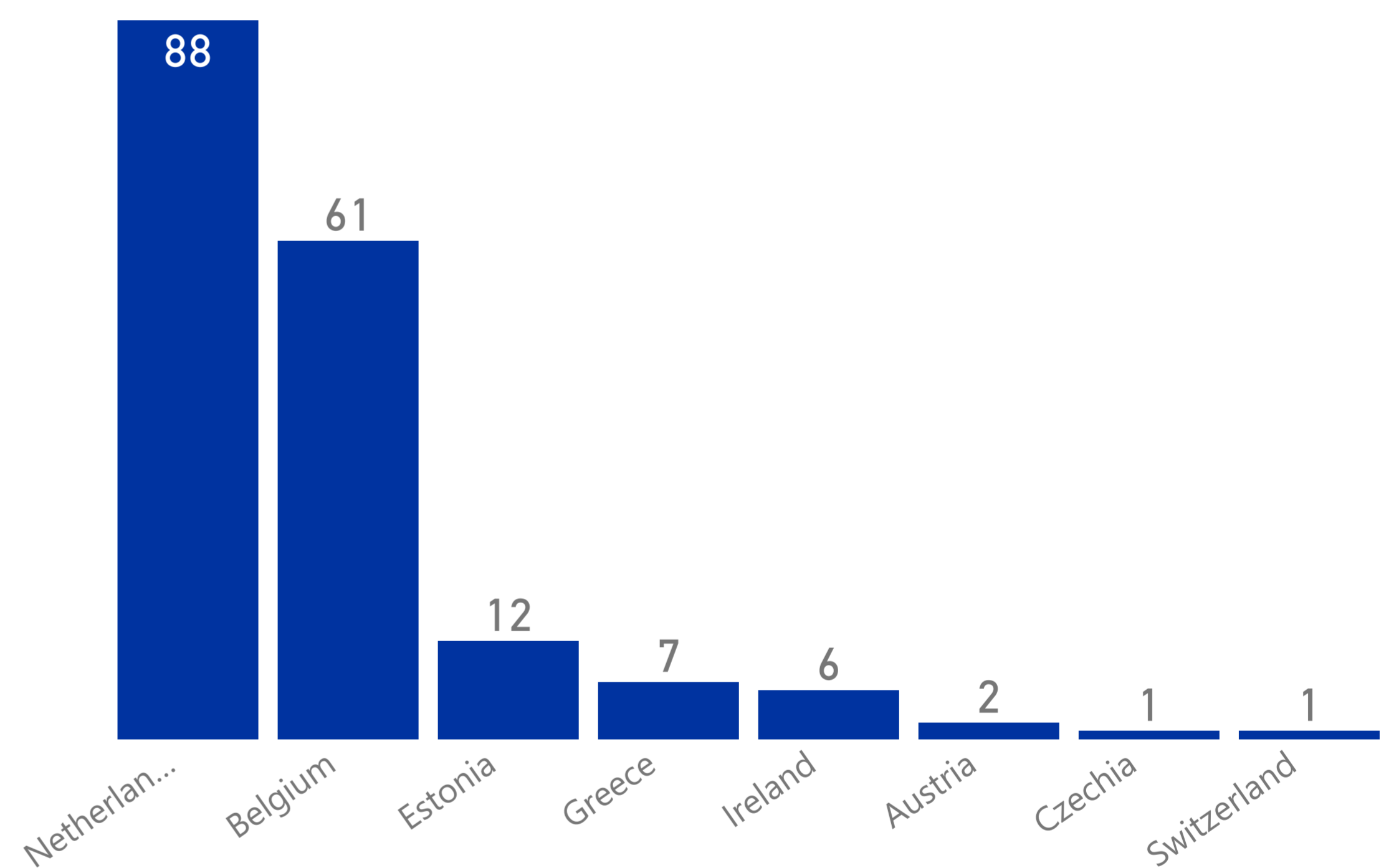
Number of AVRR Beneficiaries



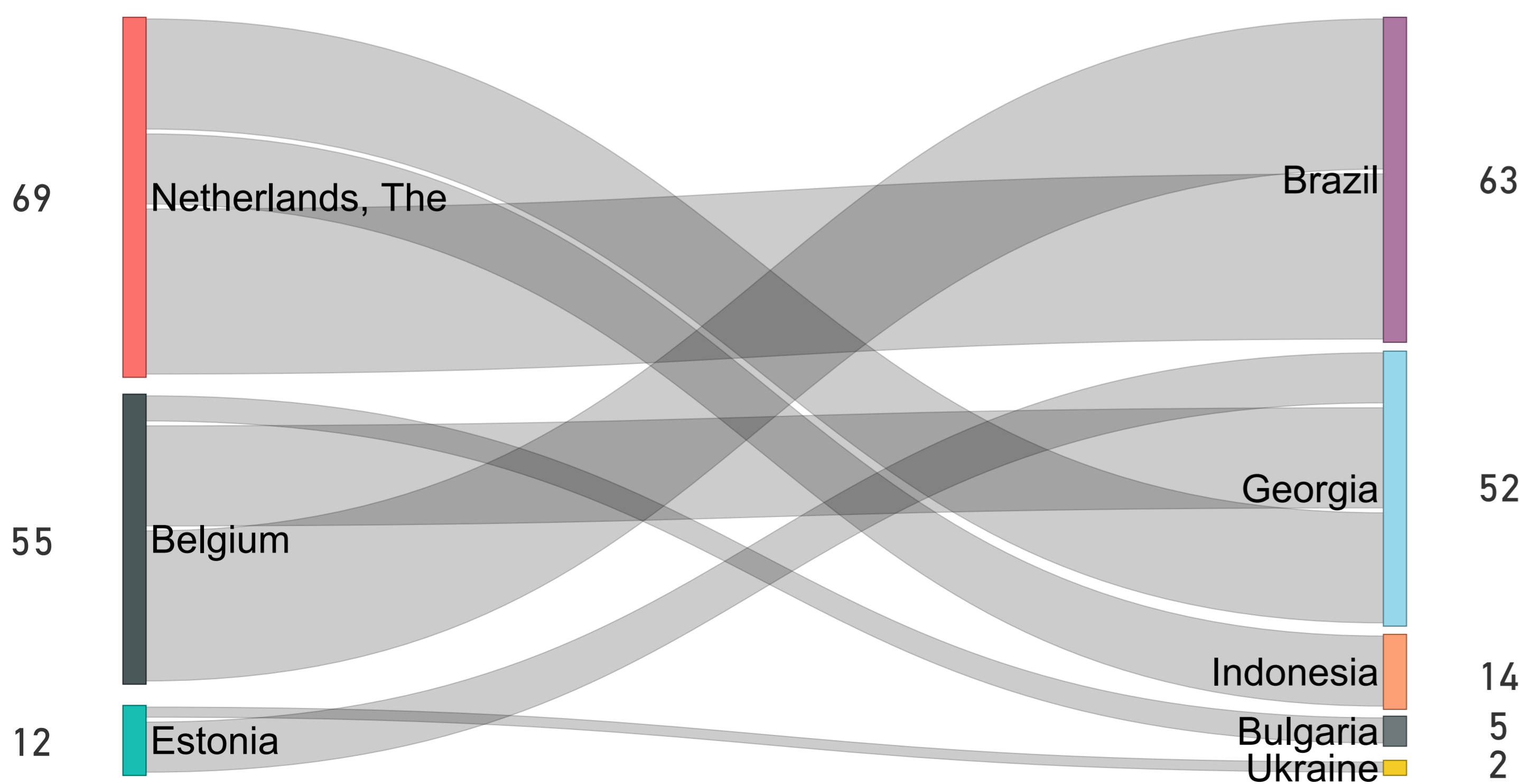
Top 10 countries/territories of origin - April 2020



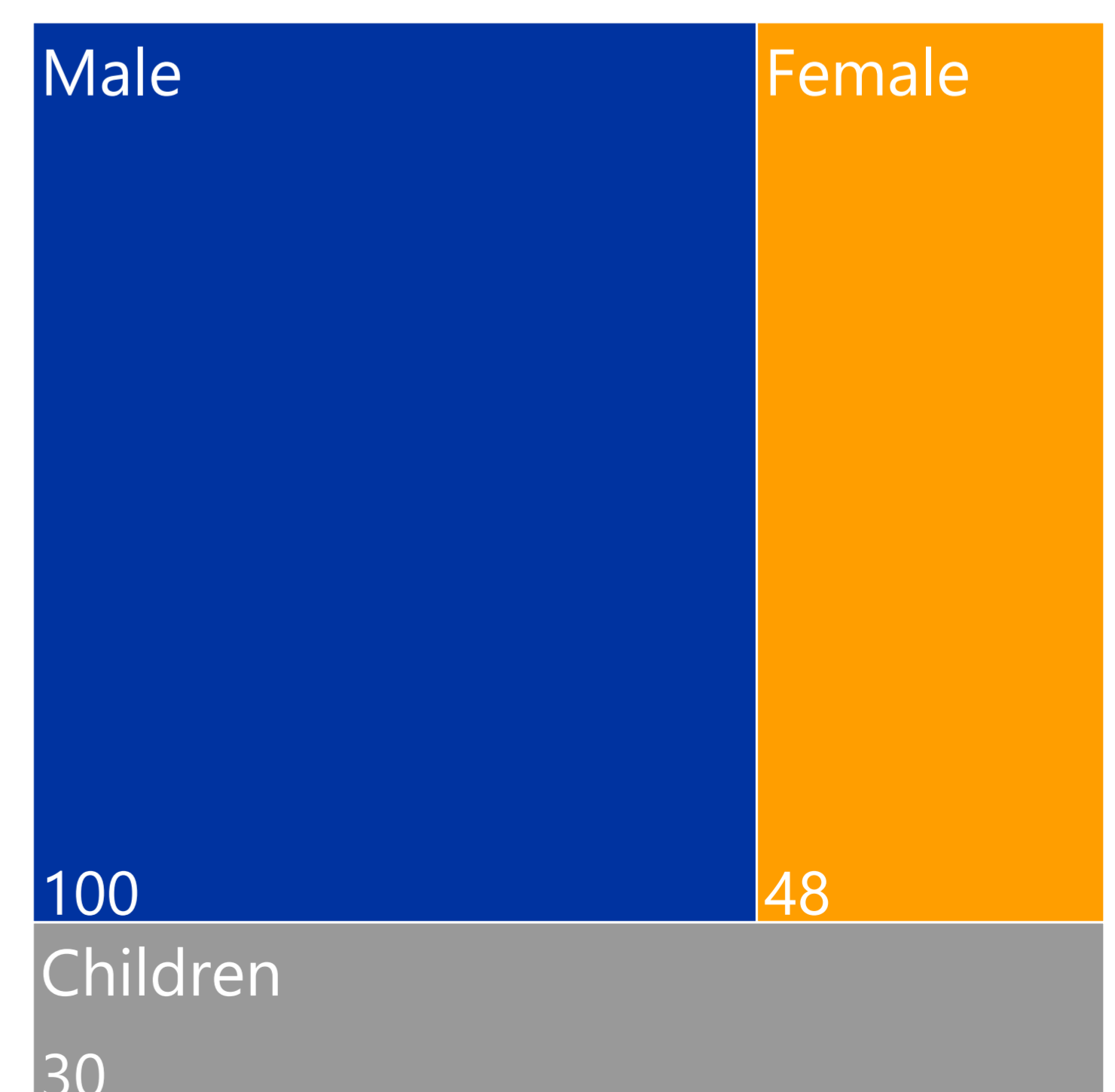
Top 10 host countries - April 2020

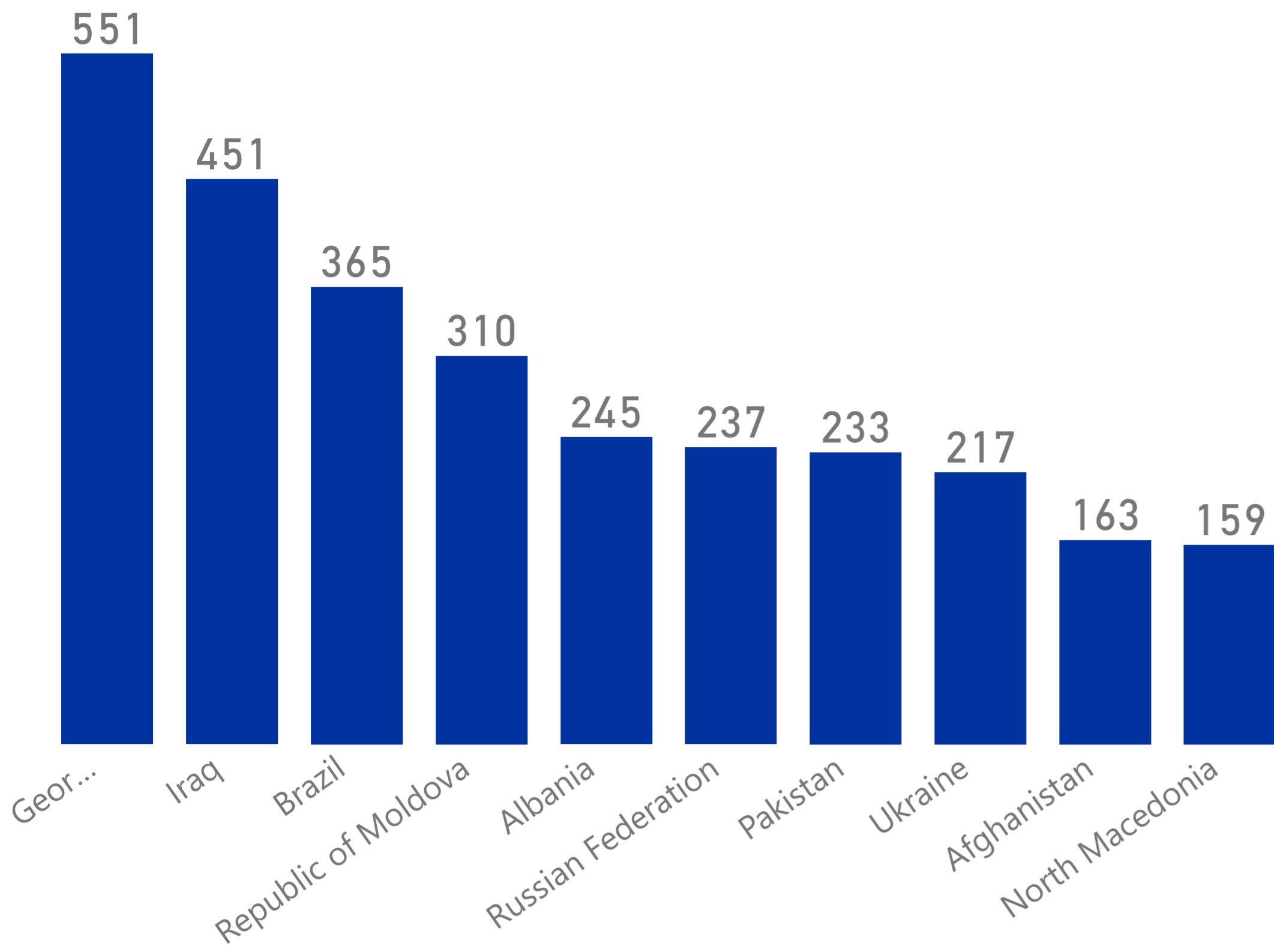


Age and sex breakdown
April 2020

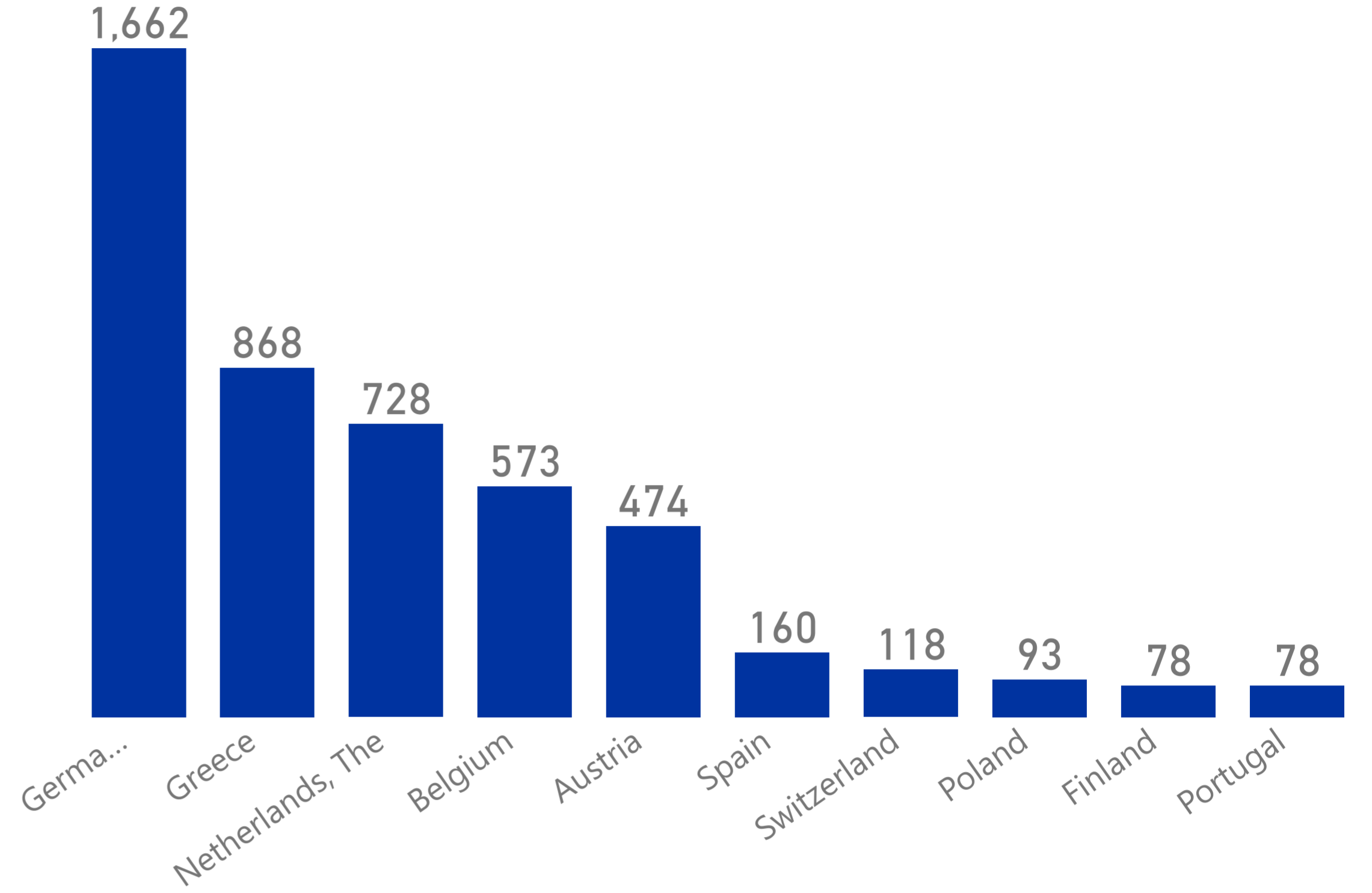

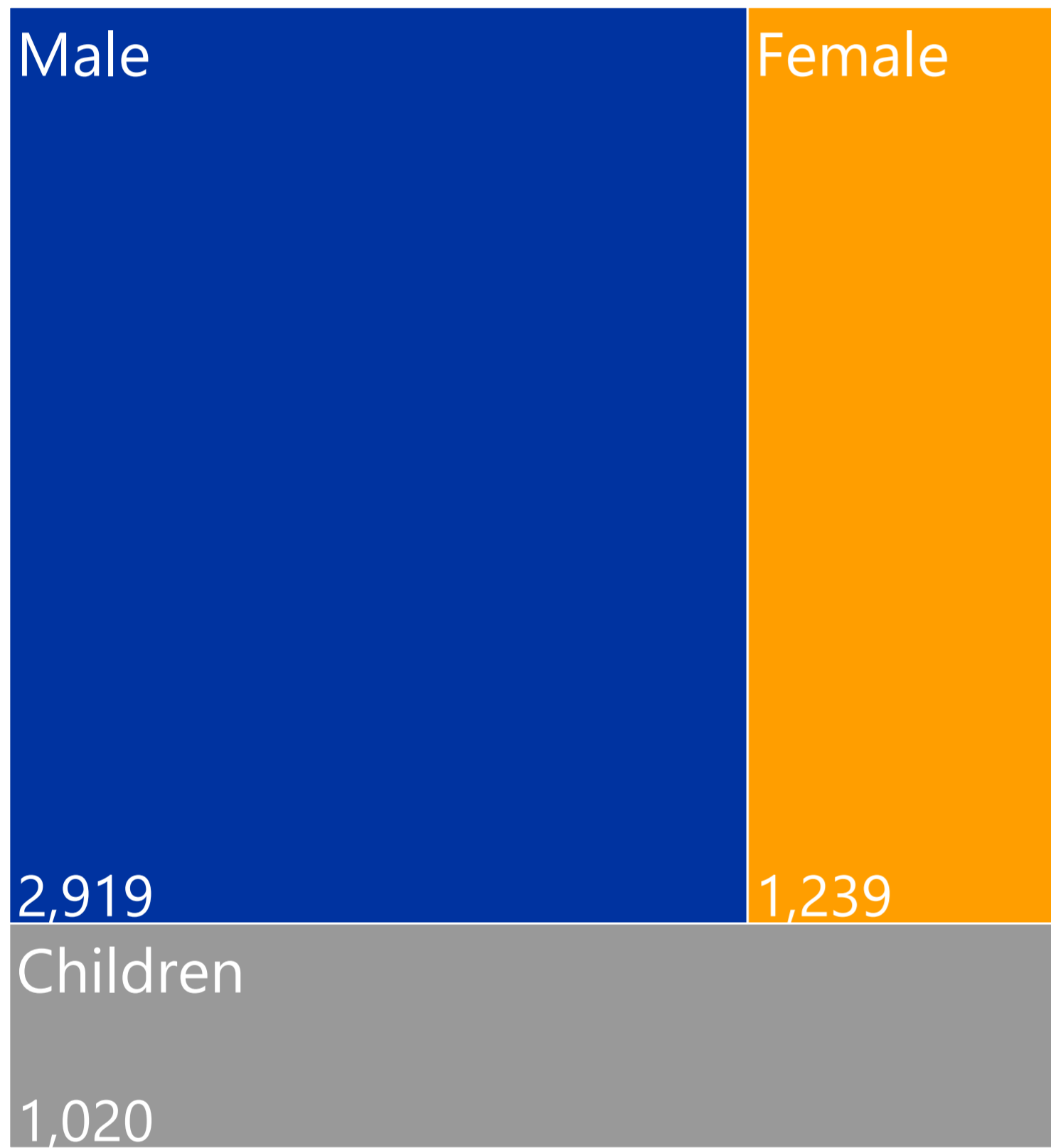
Top 10 countries/territories of origin - 2020

Definitions

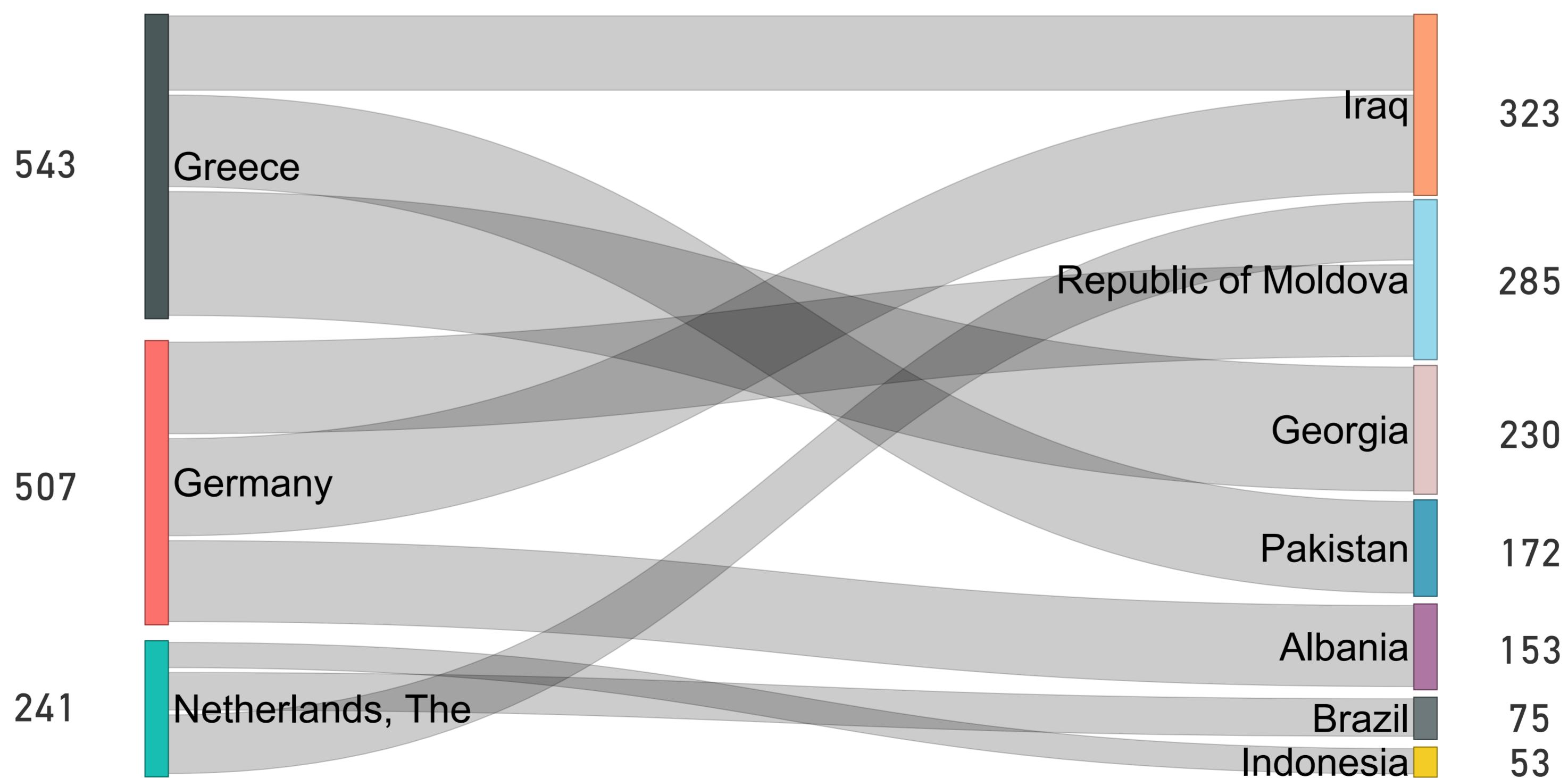
